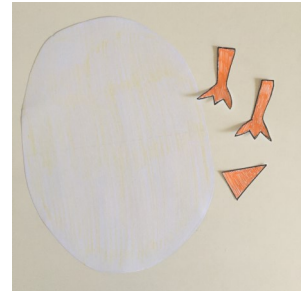
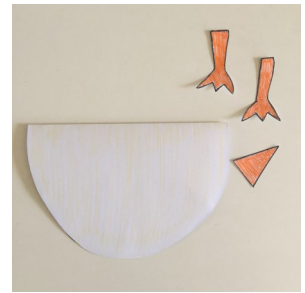


How to create your own cardstock chicken:

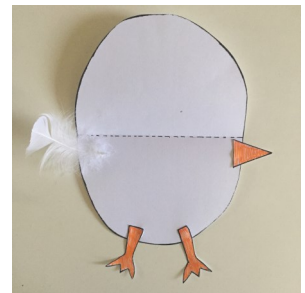
1. Color your chicken's feet and beak, and then cut them out. Cut out the body and then color the side without the dotted line.



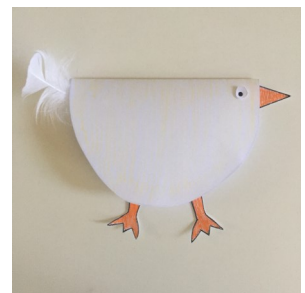
2. Fold your chicken's body in half, along the dotted line.



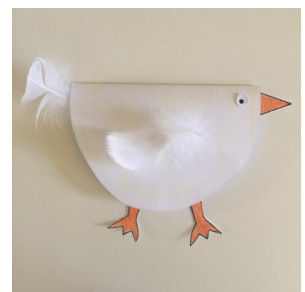
3. Unfold the chicken's body. Just below the dotted line on the right side, glue the beak. Just below the dotted line on the left side, glue one or two feathers for the tail. Glue the feet at the edge of the body at the bottom. Let all the glue dry.



4. Once the glue is dry, fold your chicken's body in half again. Add a googly eye to the front and back, near the beak. You might need an adult to help you peel the back off the googly eyes.

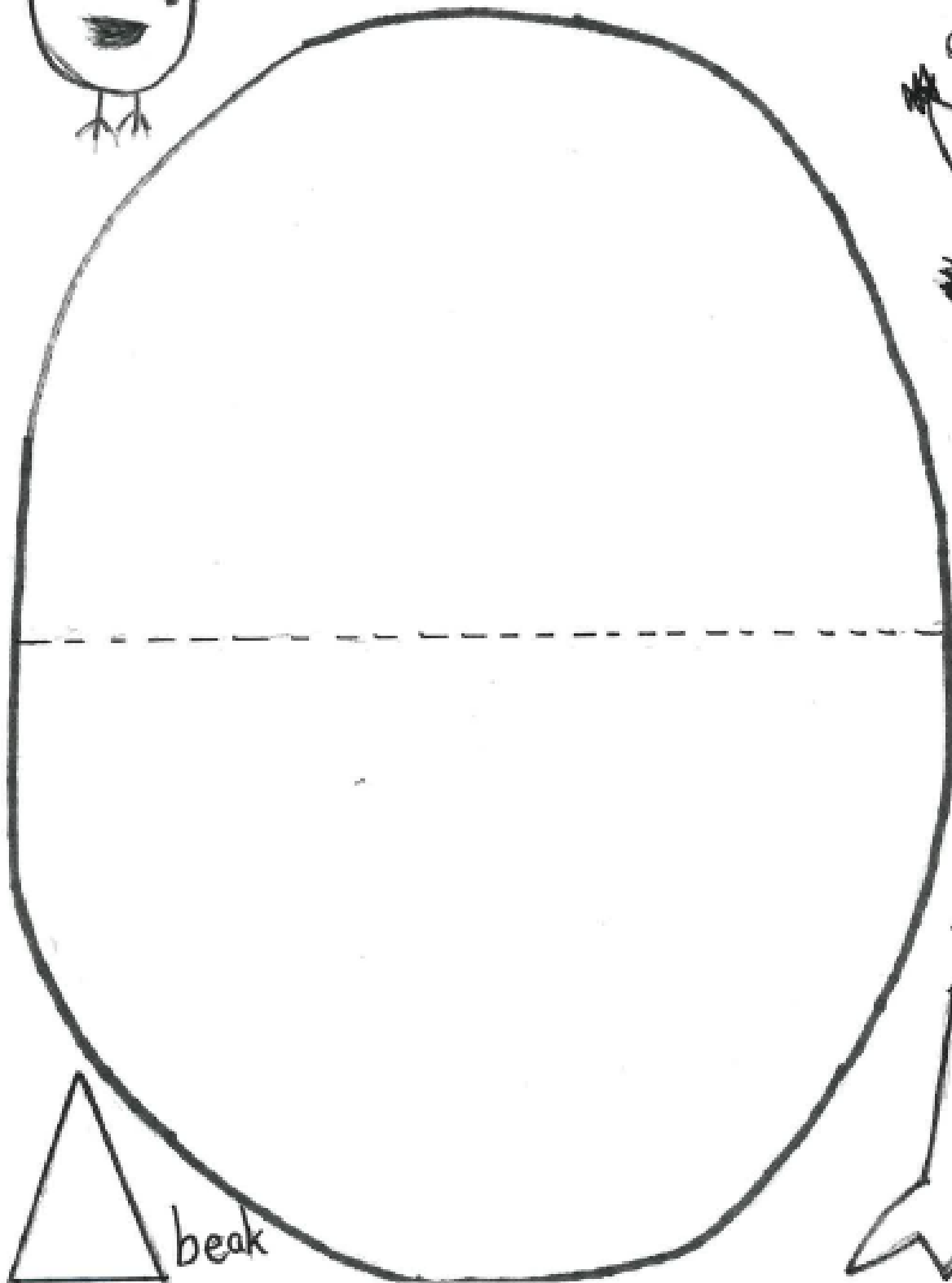


5. Give your chicken wings by gluing a feather to the middle of the space on the front as well as the middle of the space on the back.
